A letter dated 1992 March 25 was received from Mr. Robert D. Ingram, Secretary-Treasurer, School District No. 41 - Burnaby advising that during the 1991/92 school year, 28 elementary schools in the District operated school patrols which involved a total of 1120 students. In support of this program, the Corporation of the District of Burnaby has, in past years, forwarded a grant which has been distributed to the schools on the basis of the number of pupils participating.
