RE : FUNDING FOR CONSTRUCTION OF CENTENNIAL ROSE GARDEN AND  
INTERPRETIVE SIGNAGE FOR PLAYGROUND OF THE GODS AT BURNABY  
MOUNTAIN

PURPOSE : To request Council's approval of the expenditure prior to the adoption of the 1992-1996 Capital Budget and of a Parkland Acquisition Levy Reserve Interest Expenditure Bylaw in the amount of \$40,000 for the continuation of construction of the Centennial Rose Garden.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT the expenditure prior to the adoption of the 1992-1996 Capital Budget be approved for the continuation of construction of the Centennial Rose Garden.
2. THAT a Parkland Acquisition Levy Reserve Interest Expenditure Bylaw in the amount of \$40,000 be brought down for the continuation of construction of the Centennial Rose Garden.

REPORT

At its meeting of 1992 January 08, the Parks & Recreation Commission approved the expenditure of \$40,000 prior to the adoption of the 1992-1996 Capital Budget for the continuation of construction of the Centennial Rose Garden. The final construction items would include pathway paving, site furniture, pergola and arch, miniature rose planter, decorative signage, plaque and rose labels.

It is necessary for work to be initiated immediately to allow for completion of the gardens and plant establishment prior to their formal opening in spring or summer 1992. Consequently, Council approval is requested for prior expenditure of funds and for a Parkland Acquisition Levy Reserve Interest Expenditure Bylaw in the amount of \$40,000.
