At the regular Council meeting held on 1992 June 01, Council received correspondence from the Burnaby Civic Employees' Union Local 23 requesting that a municipal employee be permitted a paid leave of absence to participate in the 1992 United Way Loaned Representative Program. Council referred this request to the Executive Committee for review and the following report outlines the results of that review.

Participants in the Loaned Representative Program involves paid leave of absence from work commencing on a full-time basis, from 1992 August 24 up to and including 1992 November 27, to assist with the annual United Way fund raising campaign.

In view of the valuable service provided to our community by the United Way, the Executive Committee is recommending the municipality participate in the 1992 Loaned Representative Program by providing a paid of leave of absence for a municipal employee for a period of fourteen weeks.
