REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

A meeting of the Executive Committee of Council was held on 1992 February 10 to consider the following grant applications and submit the following majority recommendations for Council's approval.

11/92 BURNABY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$2,000 be awarded to the Burnaby Historical Society for the year 1992.

REPORT

An application was received requesting a grant in the amount of \$2,000 to assist in keeping the Burnaby Community Archive functioning through 1992 or until (or if) the municipality assumes the financial and staffing responsibility for the Archive before the end of 1992 and for the promoting and hosting of the B.C. Historical Federation Convention 1992 May 07 to 09.

Council approved: 1991 - \$2,000
 1989 - \$1,000

The Executive Committee of Council recommends that a grant in the amount of \$2,000 be awarded to the Burnaby Historical Society.

12/92 CLIFF AVENUE GIRLS SOCCER TEAM

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$1,540 (\$110 per child - 14 girls) be awarded to the Cliff Avenue Girls Soccer Team for the year 1992.

REPORT

A grant application was received requesting a grant to defray costs incurred while competing for the 2nd National Girls Soccer title in Edmonton, Alberta where the National title was won for a second time. The costs were incurred by 14 girls, 1 coach, 1 manager and 1 chaperon. Thirteen of the fourteen under 16 team were also on the under 14 team that won the National title in 1989.

Council approved: 1989 - \$1,500

The Executive Committee of Council recommends that a grant in the amount of \$110 (14 girls) for a total of \$1,540 be awarded to the Cliff Avenue Girls Soccer Team.

BOY SCOUTS OF CANADARECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$3,600 be awarded to the Boy Scouts of Canada Burnaby Region for the year 1992.

REPORT

An application was received requesting a grant to assist in the areas of Volunteer Recruitment and Development, Membership, Sponsorship and Growth, Multiculturalism, Promotion and Publicity and Special Events assistance. The Burnaby Region for 1992 is asking for support in the form of a \$4,000 grant.

Council approved: 1991 - \$3,000
 1990 - \$2,625
 1989 - \$2,500

The Executive Committee of Council recommends that a grant in the amount of \$3,600 be awarded to the Boy Scouts of Canada Burnaby Region for 1992.

FORUM FOR YOUNG CANADIANSRECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT this grant application be denied.

REPORT

An application has been received from a Burnaby North student requesting assistance with the tuition fee of \$630 and travel fee to Ottawa of \$195 to participate in the Forum for Young Canadians. This non-profit organization provides students with a week long intensive study of the processes of government in Canada. Forum for Young Canadians has been educating young people since March 1976.

After consideration of this application the Executive Committee of Council agreed that it does not fall within Council's guidelines for awarding grants and therefore recommend it be denied.

JOY E. GILMORERECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$1,000 be awarded to Mrs. Joy E. Gilmore for expenses associated with the Fetal Alcohol Syndrome Campaign.

REPORT

An application was received requesting a grant in the amount of \$1,808.85 which would compensate for expenses incurred associated with the Fetal Alcohol Syndrome Campaign. This campaign involved the posting of alcohol awareness warning signs in all establishments that serve and sell alcohol beverages in the Municipality of Burnaby.
