RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council authorize the Burnaby Family Court and Youth Justice Committee to hold a Public Information Meeting on Family Violence and that the associated administrative expenditures be approved.

REPORT

The Burnaby Family Court and Youth Justice Committee at its meeting held on 1992 February 05 discussed plans to host a Public Information Meeting on Family Violence. Tentative arrangements have been made for Wednesday, 1992 April 29 at 7:00 p.m. at the Capitol Hill Community Hall, 361 South Howard, North Burnaby, B.C.

The purpose of the meeting is to provide general background information relating to family violence, what is available when it happens and the preventive measures.

The panel format would include representatives from the Burnaby Mental Health Services, Battered Women's Support Services, Life Line Society, Burnaby RCMP, OIC - Operational Support, RCMP - Crime Prevention/Victim Assistance, Burnaby Crown Counsel, Burnaby Family Court Counselling and Burnaby Family Life.

There will be minimal costs associated with the hosting of the public meeting i.e. sound equipment, administrative costs at an estimated cost of \$500.

The intent of this report is to advise Council of the Committee's plan. Should Council have any suggestions or concerns with regard to the Public Information Meeting on Family Violence, we invite your comments at your earliest possible convenience.
