COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

The following summarizes policing activities for Burnaby Detachment for the 1st Quarter.

The Detachment responded to 19,228 calls for service during the first 3 months. This represents a 2.4% increase over last year to date.

General Investigation Section

Armed robberies and thefts of auto are down compared to the first quarter of 1991. Reported armed robberies showed a 30% decrease while thefts of auto dropped 19% over the same period last year.

The number of break and enters show no change from the first quarter of 1991. There were 730 residence Break and Enters and 351 business Break and Enters reported during the first three months of this year.

Quarter end statistics revealed criminal code offenses against persons are down 10% with crimes against property virtually unchanged.

Drug Section

The Drug Enforcement Section continues to be very active investigating marijuana grow operations and drug conspiracy files. As well, a successful under cover operation was concluded in February. In the first 3 months of this year, 235 drug related offenses were investigated. This represents a 5% decrease over the same period last year.

Traffic Section

The Traffic Section investigated 5 fatal accidents during the first quarter. The same number were investigated in 1991. Injury accidents were up 18% during this time frame while overall traffic collisions were down 5%. A total of 90 persons were charged with alcohol related driving offenses.

Ident. Section

The Identification Section attended 545 crime scenes during the first three months of this year. 38 criminal identifications were made during this quarter.
