**60-60-018** Continuing Program of Asbestos Abatement

**Charge:** 1991-1995 Capital Budget \$40,000  
Code 60 - Municipal Hall Complex

**Additional Information:** The Corporation has on file with the Workers' Compensation Board an Asbestos Compliance Plan which outlines an action plan including a semi-annual inspection and vacuuming of the asbestos containing materials within the Municipal Hall. A recent inspection identified the need for vacuuming within the ceiling space in compliance with the Board's requirement. This work order provides additional funding for consultancy services and costs associated with ongoing work consistent with our Compliance Plan. Funds are available in the 1991-1995 Capital Budget, Code 60, Municipal Hall Complex.


**60-21-097** Watermain on Sperling Avenue, Winston to Claude

**Charge:** 1991-1995 Capital Budget \$500,000  
Code 21 - Mains, Pumping Stations, etc.

**Additional Information:** Appearing elsewhere on Council's agenda is an item recommending award of Contract #9201 for watermain construction on Sperling Avenue, Winston to Claude Street. The new main will improve supply and fire flow protection to surrounding areas. A section of the main is to be installed on an existing timber bridge crossing Still Creek. The structural condition of the bridge is not sound and is due for replacement within the next five years. In view of the competitive pricing on this contract, it is desirable to take advantage of the opportunity to replace the bridge at this time.

The original budget of \$660,000 allocated for this project is adequate to cover the tender price and the estimated additional cost of \$75,000 required for the bridge replacement work. The Provincial Government has approved a 25% Revenue Sharing Grant for this project. The additional bridge replacement cost will be included in the overall project costs for revenue sharing purposes.

This work order is being raised to cover the tender price of Contract #9201, engineering fees and construction cost associated with the bridge replacement and other ancillary work by Municipal forces. Funding for these expenditures are in accordance with the draft 1992 Provisional Capital Budget under Code 21 - Mains, Pumping Stations, etc.
