REPORT

Environmental Health Services staff contacted Mr. Chow, one of Coconuts Night Club partners, on 1992 October 28 regarding noise disturbances from the subject club and were provided with the following information - that the club will go to a country and western format in the near future. It is Environmental Health Services understanding that the club will close temporarily at the end of 1992 November for approximately six weeks to accommodate renovations.

The Management of Coconuts Night Club believes that the change in music format will reduce concerns related to noise from both within and outside the club.

Environmental Health Services staff will monitor noise emanating from the subject operation once the new format is in place and will provide an updated report to Council.
