REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

A meeting of the Executive Committee of Council was held on 1992 June 15 to consider the following grant applications and submit the following majority recommendations for Council's approval:

48/92 ROYAL CITY YOUTH BALLET COMPANY

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT this grant application be denied.

R E P O R T

A letter of application has been received requesting a grant to assist with costs to attend and perform at Disneyland's Magic Music Days 1992 July 19, 20 and 21. Performances are at Disneyland, Disneyland Hotel and the Queen Mary. As well there will be organized workshops with the Los Angeles Ballet Company and an additional performance at Knott's Berry Farm.

Although recognizing the valuable work the Royal City Youth Ballet Company performs, the Executive Committee of Council recommends that this grant application be denied as it does not fall within Council's guidelines for awarding grants.

51/92 UNITED WAY

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$13,000 be awarded to United Way of the Lower Mainland for the year 1992.

R E P O R T

An application has been received from the United Way of the Lower Mainland requesting a grant in the amount of \$13,000 to assist with the provision of services to Burnaby.

For over 30 years, the United Way of the Lower Mainland has served the Burnaby Community through provision of social planning and community development resources in addition to the provision of financial support to Burnaby non-profit social service agencies. Staffing has been provided to the United Way Burnaby Inter-Agency Council, its Task Forces and Committees.

Council awarded: 1991 - \$14,000
1990 - \$ 7,000
1989 - \$13,000

It is the recommendation of the Executive Committee of Council that a grant in the amount of \$13,000 be awarded to the United Way of the Lower Mainland for the year 1992.

52/92 BIG SISTERS OF BC LOWER MAINLANDRECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$3,400 be awarded to Big Sisters of BC Lower Mainland for the year 1992.

R E P O R T

An application has been received from the Big Sisters of BC Lower Mainland organization requesting a grant in the amount of \$3,500 for the 1992 fiscal year to support the services provided to the children and families of Burnaby.

1990 - \$3,150
1989 - \$3,150

It is the recommendation of the Executive Committee of Council that a grant in the amount of \$3,400 be awarded to Big Sisters of BC Lower Mainland for the year 1992.

53/92 ODYSSEY OF THE MIND WORLD FINALS
(Confederation Park School)RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$400 (\$100 per child) be awarded to the Confederation Park School OM Team c/o Confederation Park School for the year 1992.

R E P O R T

The Confederation Park School has submitted a letter requesting a grant to assist with expenses incurred while travelling to Odyssey of the Mind World Finals in Boulder, Colorado, May 27 - 31 1992.

The Executive Committee of Council recommends that a grant in the amount of \$400 (\$100 per child) be awarded to the Confederation Park School OM Team for the year 1992.

55/92 BURNABY MULTICULTURAL SOCIETYRECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT this grant application be denied.

R E P O R T

An application has been received requesting a grant in the amount of \$1,500 to assist in the process of developing a resource handbook for immigrant women in Burnaby, New Westminster, Coquitlam, Port Coquitlam and Port Moody. The handbook, which will be approximately 100 pages, would list resources such as ESL classes, child care support services and other vital services not easily accessed through mainstream directories. Estimated cost of the project is \$8,762 for 500 copies (spiral bound).

Council awarded: 1992 - \$500, \$5,000
1991 - \$5,250
1990 - \$2,000

It is the recommendation of the Executive Committee of Council that this grant application be denied at this time due to the fact that two grant amounts have been awarded to the Burnaby Multicultural Society for 1992.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT this grant application be denied.

R E P O R T

An application was received requesting a grant to assist with Dance Free '92.

Dance Free '92 is a dance whereby a venue is provided with no alcohol served and no cost involved to attend. The attendance has grown from 750 people, when the dance was started 6 years, to 2,500 people who attended last year's dance.

After consideration of this application the Executive Committee of Council agreed that it does not fall within Council's guidelines for awarding grants and therefore recommend that the grant be denied.
