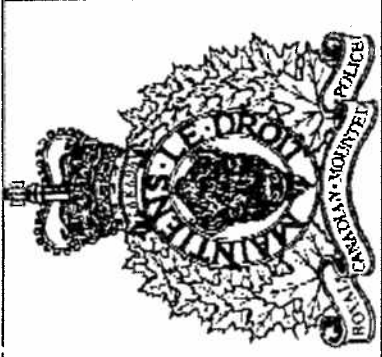

RE: MUNICIPAL POLICING QUARTERLY REPORT

The following summarizes policing activities for Burnaby Detachment for the 2nd quarter.

The detachment responded to 20,300 calls for service during the past 3 months. This represents a 25% increase over last year to date.

GENERAL INVESTIGATION SECTION

The number of Armed Robberies reported this quarter is down 14% compared to the 2nd quarter of 1991. Year to date statistics reveal robberies have decreased 21%.

Auto Thefts remain the same this quarter as last year. Overall auto thefts have dropped 9% year to date.

The number of Break and Enters has increased by 1% this quarter. To date, a total of 685 business Break and Enters and 1,253 residential Break and Enters have been reported.

Criminal Code offenses against persons are down 3% with crimes against property down 2%.

DRUG SECTION

The Drug Enforcement Section remained committed to a number of conspiracy trials currently before the Courts. A total of 256 Drug related offenses were investigated this quarter which represents a 38% increase over the same period last year. Drug offenses are up 17% for the first half of this year.

TRAFFIC SECTION

The Traffic Section investigated 2 fatal accidents this period while none were reported last year. A total of 6 fatal accidents have occurred to date with last years total being 4 for the first 6 months. Injury accidents are up 2% this quarter while total collisions are down 17%. A total of 93 persons were charged with alcohol related driving offenses.

IDENT. SECTION

The Ident. Section attended 518 crime scenes this quarter, with 48 criminal identifications made during that period.
