SUBJECT: 'JUST FOR KIDS' PARADE

PURPOSE: To seek Council approval for the 'Just for Kids' Parade.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT Council approve the 'Just for Kids' parade as discussed in this report.

REPORT

A request to use Municipal streets for a 'Just for Kids' parade on 1992 September 05 has been received from the Pacific National Exhibition.

This type of request is considered as a 'parade' approval in the context of the Street & Traffic Bylaw.

The parade will assemble at 50 S. Gilmore (Gilmore School) at 9:00am and move off at 10:00am. The parade will then proceed south on Gilmore to Hastings, west on Hastings to Boundary, north on Boundary to Albert Street in Vancouver.

The organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the parade be conducted under the supervision of one person as marshal or organizer.
2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of the individuals encountered en route.
3. That the parade be covered with liability insurance in the minimum amount of \$2 million with the Municipality of Burnaby named as co-insured, and that the insurance policy include a 30 day cancellation notice and a cross liability clause.

As this parade requires a temporary, partial closure of Hastings, approval must be granted by the Ministry of Transportation & Highways.
