RE : 1992 PLAYGROUND CONSTRUCTION
PURPOSE : To request Council to bring forward a Parkland Acquisition Levy Reserve Interest Expenditure Bylaw for the construction of a playground in Ernie Winch Park and to bring forward a Capital Reserves Bylaw for the constuction of a playground in Willingdon Heights Park and to request Council's approval of the expenditure for the Willingdon Heights Park playground prior to the adoption of the 1992-1996 Capital Budget.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT a Parkland Acquisition Levy Reserve Interest Expenditure Bylaw in the amount of \$25,000 for the construction of a playground in Ernie Winch Park be brought forward.
2. THAT the expenditure of \$25,000 for the Willingdon Heights Park playground prior to the adoption of the 1992-1996 Capital Budget be approved.
3. THAT a Capital Reserves Bylaw in the amount of \$25,000 for the construction of a playground in Willingdon Heights Park be brought forward.

REPORT

The Commission's 1992 Capital budget makes provision for the development of two playgrounds; one in Ernie Winch Park, the other in Willingdon Heights Park. The intent is to install the new facilities before the summer season and therefore all approvals need to be in place to meet that schedule.

1. Ernie Winch Park

The existing playground structure in Ernie Winch Park is outdated and has been almost totally removed because of safety concerns. A new structure will be supplied and installed by a playground manufacturing firm. The funds for this work were allocated in the Commission's 1991-1995 Capital Budget from the Parkland Acquisition Levy Interest and now forms part of the 1992 program. Council's authorization to bring down a bylaw to appropriate reserve funds is required.

2. Willingdon Heights Park

In 1990 the existing outdated play structure was removed and a new preschool-aged structure was added. This year's program is to replace the junior structure which will complete the facility. Funds for this work have been allocated in the Commission's 1992 Capital budget from Capital Reserves. Prior approval to spend these funds and authorization to bring down a bylaw to appropriate reserve funds is required from Council.
