R E P O R T

Statistics Canada, on 1992 April 28, released final population totals tabulated from the 1991 Census that are available for the Municipality of Burnaby as a whole.


The total population for the Municipality of Burnaby, as of 1991 June, was 158,858. This represents an increase of 13,697 persons, or a 9.4 percent increase, from the 1986 total of 145,161. This equates to an annual average percentage population increase of 1.89 percent.

By way of comparison, the population increase from 1981 to 1986 was 8,707 persons, or an increase of 6.4 percent. The corresponding average annual percentage population increase was 1.28 percent.

The population of the Vancouver Census Metropolitan Area increased from 1,380,729 in 1986 to 1,602,502 in 1991, an increase of 16.1 percent.

Characteristics of the population (e.g. age/sex, marital status) are to be available on a municipal wide basis as of 1992 July 7. More detailed and area specific information at the Census Tract level is anticipated to be released in 1992 August and beyond.

Staff will keep Council informed as to the results of the 1991 Census as they become available. A future edition of Information Burnaby is also planned to incorporate an article on the results of the 1991 Census.
