REPORT

Appearing under correspondence on Council's 1991 December 16 agenda was a letter from Mrs. Johanna Welling regarding the wheel-locking of her vehicle at 5021 Kingsway on 1991 November 14.

Over the holiday season we have been unable to contact Mrs. Welling to obtain details of the situation and offer assistance. Once we have contacted Mrs. Welling, we will contact Execupark Parking Ltd., the company providing the wheel-locking service to this parking facility, to ensure that signage in the lot is clear and obviously posted.

Execupark Parking Ltd. is licenced to operate a wheel-locking service in Burnaby and at present there are no regulations governing the use of wheel-locking devices to monitor parking facilities.

We are currently working with the Municipal Solicitor in the preparation of Municipal towing regulations. These regulations will include controls on the use of wheel-locking devices. We anticipate that these regulations will be forwarded for Council's consideration in the next few months.
