REPORT

This report provides information on the upcoming visit of 120 delegates of Burnaby's sister city of Kushiro, Japan.

On 1992 February 25 a letter was received from Kushiro, Japan outlining the proposed visit to take place August 21 - 23, 1992. The Kushiro delegation will include: Mayor, City Council members, Fire Chief, City staff, traditional Japanese artists and musicians as well as representatives from the School Board, Chamber of Commerce and private citizens. Their visit will coincide with Burnaby's Centennial celebrations scheduled throughout 1992.

The group will arrive in Burnaby on August 21st. They have requested that a "Kushiro Day" be proclaimed and that their artists perform for the public of Burnaby on that day. Included in the visit will also be sightseeing, a visit to Municipal Hall and a banquet. The group will depart for Victoria on August 23, 1992.

Staff are preparing a schedule of events for the Kushiro delegation which will be presented to Council for its approval.
