**RECOMMENDATION:**


**THAT** this report be received for information purposes.

**REPORT**

On 1993 June 21, Council requested information on ticketing violations involving illegal left turns. This report is in response to Council's request.

The fine for an illegal left turn prosecuted in violation of the Motor Vehicle Act is \$85.00. Besides the fine, two points are added to the driving record. If the driver's record goes over three points, the driver point premium is assessed.

Fines are paid to the Motor Vehicle Branch and the Province of British Columbia benefits. If the fine goes unpaid a conviction is entered on the driving record and no licence renewal is given until all outstanding fines are paid.
