

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT approval be granted to extend the contract with Eagle Consulting Group Inc., for the supply and installation of an automated irrigation system on the remaining seven holes of the Riverway Golf Course for a total cost of \$346,514.15, with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.
2. THAT Council be requested to concur.

REPORT

Council, at its meeting of 1991 June 17, approved the award of a contract to Eagle Consulting Group Inc. for the supply and installation of an automated irrigation system on the first nine holes of the Riverway Golf Course. Subsequently an additional two holes were added to the work of the contract. We are now ready to proceed with the seven remaining holes.

Proposals were received from the two prequalified companies, namely Eagle Consulting Group Inc., who completed the first 11 holes on Riverway, and Irri-Golf Inc., who installed the system on Burnaby Mountain Golf Course earlier this year.

The recommended bidder, Eagle Consulting Group Inc., submitted the lowest proposal. Their performance to date on the Riverway Golf Course has been very good and both staff and the golf course architect have no hesitation in recommending them to complete the final phase. Eagle Consulting Group Inc. have become familiar with the site conditions and Burnaby's expectations and will provide some continuity to this project.

Sufficient funds are available from Capital Reserves Bylaw No. 9855. The expenditure is provided for in the 1994 Riverway Golf Course - Course Development section of the Major Parks component of the 1993 - 1997 Capital Program.

The Purchasing Agent and our consultant, Golf Design Services Ltd., concur with the recommendation.
