RE: B.C. GAMES FOR THE PHYSICALLY DISABLED

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a grant of \$8,000 be provided by City Council, funding to be provided from the 1993 Annual Operating Budget Contingency, towards the cost of delivering the 1993 B.C. Games for the Physically Disabled which are to be staged in Burnaby between 1993 July 7 and 11.

R E P O R T

The Executive Committee of Council, at its meeting held on 1993 March 29 received an application for funding from the B.C. Sport and Fitness Council requesting assistance towards the B.C. Games for the Physically Disabled. The Executive Committee of Council, at its meeting held on 1993 June 14, received a delegation representing the B.C. Games for the Physically Disabled who were in attendance to address an application for funding and to provide an outline for the Committee on preparations that have been organized to date.

After reviewing the application, the Committee members requested the Parks and Recreation Commission to provide further information to the Executive Committee on the B.C. Games for the Physically Disabled.

The Executive Committee of Council has received a report from the Parks and Recreation Commission (attached) in response to the Committee's request.

SUBJECT: 1993 B.C. GAMES FOR THE PHYSICALLY DISABLED

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a grant of \$8,000 be provided by City Council, funding to be provided from the 1993 Annual Operating Budget contingency, towards the cost of delivering the 1993 B.C. Games for the Physically Disabled which are to be staged in Burnaby between 1993 July 7th and 11th.

REPORT

The B.C. Sport and Fitness Council for the Disabled have requested that the City of Burnaby's Council contribute \$8,000 towards the cost of the 1993 B.C. Games for the Physically Disabled.

The Executive Committee of Council has asked for the Parks and Recreation Commission's consideration on this request. The grant would be a one-time only grant.

The Games are administered by the B.C. Sport and Fitness Council for the Disabled. The primary sponsors for the Games are B.C. Sport and Fitness Council for the Disabled, Canada Safeway, Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Recreation and Housing.

The Games will be held 1993 July 7th - 11th. Burnaby is the designed host community. Attached is a schedule of venues and times.

The Games will be held in a number of Burnaby recreation facilities. The facilities have been allocated to the Games at the normal preferred recreation rates. The value of the Burnaby allotments and support services is approximately \$7,000.

The Games organizers are also facing other costs beyond the core expenses, for example, equipment setup in our venues, transportation, stages and bleachers, and insurance.

The Games are a valuable service to the disabled athletes of our community and we are pleased that they have chosen Burnaby for this year's games.

With the contribution of \$8,000, Burnaby will be profiled as a co-sponsor of the Games.

Burnaby's Support

The Games will be delivered through the efforts of many volunteers, 90% of which are from Burnaby. The Burnaby Fire Department will provide volunteers for security at the opening ceremonies and venues, class 3 drivers for shuttle buses, an emergency team on standby and provision of their mobile trailer as a medical centre at Swangard.

The Parks and Recreation Department will assist with promotion, staff and support services at all venues.

Burnaby Recognition

The City will be profiled by being featured as a co-sponsor and represented officially at opening and closing ceremonies, named in press releases, signage, registration kits, programs and given full coverage on Cable 4 and recorded on a video of Games in Burnaby for future reference when organizing future games.

The Games organizers have chosen to hold their guest reception on July 8th at the Carousel site in Burnaby Village Museum and their closing ceremonies on July 11th at Burnaby Lake Sports Complex in conjunction with our main festival of the year--Burnaby Lake Discovery Day.

It is recommended that \$8,000 be contributed to this important event.
