
REPORT

The Commission has within its 1993 Capital Program \$6,000 for contribution to school playground projects. The standard established over the past few years has been to assist school projects with funding of \$3,000.

There is only one project ready to proceed this year. The Inman Parent Group have raised the necessary funds including the Commission's \$3,000 to complete the first phase of this project. The total cost of Phase I is \$9,335.50.

The School District has confirmed that they support this project and that the Parent Group is in a position to purchase the play equipment.

At its meeting of 1993 June 16, the Parks and Recreation Commission by motion approved the allocation of \$3,000 from the 1993 Capital Budget to the Inman School playground project and now recommends to Council that a bylaw be brought forward to enter into an agreement with the Burnaby School Board to contribute to the cost of playground equipment as detailed in this report.
