REPORT

On 1991 October 07, Council received a report on Rezoning Reference #5/90 which proposes a major phased, mixed-use, comprehensive development within the Brentwood Town Centre. Phase I of the development proposal involves an interim retail beer and wine store to be constructed within the east end of the existing Lougheed Hotel. This proposed retail beer and wine store is interim in that in a future phase comprising retail mall development and the demolition of the hotel, a new beer and wine store is proposed to be located in a specified area within the retail mall (subject to applicable Provincial legislation and Municipal approval requirements at the time). Rezoning Reference #5/90 was given Second Reading by Council on 1991 November 04.
