PURPOSE: To request Council to give prior approval for the expenditure for phase II of Riverway Golf Course grounds development and to bring down a Capital Reserves Bylaw to finance the completion of the

Riverway Golf Course grounds development.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

THAT prior approval be given for the expenditure of \$795,000 for phase II of Riverway Golf Course grounds development, prior to the adoption of the 1993 - 1997 Capital Budget.

THAT a Capital Reserves Bylaw in the amount of \$1,560,000 be brought down to finance the completion of the Riverway Golf Course grounds development.

REPORT

The Golf Course construction is proceeding well and this prior funding approval is required to complete the landscape construction for the planned opening of the first nine holes in July 1993 and the second nine holes in July 1995.

At its meeting of 1993 January 20, the Parks & Recreation Commission received the attached staff report on the above subject and adopted the three recommendations contained therein.

RE: RIVERWAY GOLF COURSE DEVELOPMENT

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. THAT the Commission approve the expenditure of \$1,560,000 for the completion of Riverway Golf Course Grounds Development.
- 2. THAT Council be asked to give prior approval for the expenditure of \$795,000 for phase II of Riverway Golf Course grounds development, prior to the adoption of the 1993-1997 Capital Budget.
- 3. THAT Council be asked to bring down a Capital Reserves bylaw in the amount of \$1,560,000 to finance the completion of the Riverway Golf Course grounds development.

REPORT

The Riverway Golf Course peat removal operation and golf course construction is proceeding well and on schedule for the planned opening of the first nine holes on 1 July 1993 with the second nine holes scheduled for opening in July 1995. To date, the following work has been completed:

- * ten holes have been constructed
- * the works yard is completed
- * the driving range is shaped and ready for seeding and fencing
- * service roads and cart paths are in place
- * extensive perimeter landscaping and tree planting completed
- * sand trap perimeters are shaped and ready to have the sand placed.

A critical timeline for the completion of development has been developed. Based on that, a projected cash flow expenditure has been formulated for 1993 and 1994 as follows:
