
**R E P O R T**

In 1993 February, Council approved a recommendation of the Community Issues & Social Planning Committee for the submission of a grant proposal to Multiculturalism and Citizenship Canada for funding to undertake a community consultation process with selected ethnic groups in Burnaby. On 1993 June 4, the Minister of Multiculturalism and Citizenship Canada approved funding for the project in the amount of \$12,000.

The key objective of the project is to collect information on barriers to obtaining services as experienced by ethnic groups in Burnaby, and to develop specific recommendations for changes that would improve services, access and participation for members of Burnaby's ethnic communities.

Staff will be preparing the necessary advertisement and background materials for the selection of a consultant to assist staff in undertaking this project. Staff will advise the Committee of the selected project consultant. It is anticipated that the project will commence in 1993 September.
