R E P O R T

The City of Burnaby currently does not have representation on two of the G.V.R.D. Committees, Parks and Solid Waste Management, whose deliberations and recommendations could have a significant impact on our community. Representation on the Parks Committee is important because one of the G.V.R.D. Regional Parks is located within our boundaries and it is desirable that Council have direct input into the formulation of regional park policy. With respect to the G.V.R.D. Solid Waste Management Committee, the location of the regional incinerator within Burnaby makes it essential that Council's position on related issues be directly conveyed to any committee dealing with Solid Waste Management. Also, Council requires to be a part of any decisions that are made respecting the incinerator and its operation. It is because of the necessity that Burnaby be directly involved in the decision making process concerning Regional Parks and Solid Waste Management that I am bringing forward the first two recommendations of the report. I am asking that the Chairman of the G.V.R.D. consider the importance of our request and make the requested appointments.

The additional appointments to the Bicycle Committee were necessary to give the committee a better balanced viewpoint and be more representative of the community.

The one additional appointment to the Heritage Advisory Committee is a result of now having received a 'Recommendation for Appointment' from the Architectural Institute of B. C. to replace its previous representative on the committee.
