**SUBJECT: GOVERNMENT ROAD IMPROVEMENTS - LOUGHEED HIGHWAY  
TO SOUTH OF MANCHESTER DRIVE**

**PURPOSE:** To seek Council authority to expend \$40,000 for engineering services for road improvements to Government Road from Lougheed Highway to south of Manchester Drive.

---

**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. **THAT** Council authorize the expenditure of \$40,000 for the provision of engineering services for improvements to Government Road from Lougheed Highway to south of Manchester Drive.

**REPORT**

At its regular meeting of 1993 February 01, Council approved a recommendation to include road improvements on Government Road from the Lougheed Highway south as a 1993 item in the 1993-1997 Capital Program for major roads.

In order to meet the 1993 construction time table for this project it is necessary to undertake the detailed design at this time. Council authority is needed to proceed with this work.

The estimated cost of engineering services for this project including design and construction supervision is \$40,000.

The 1993-1997 Draft Capital Budget shows an amount of \$610,000 for this project to be expended in 1993. It is intended that the cost of the engineering services be interim financed from Capital Contingency until such time as the Capital Expenditure Bylaw is raised to finance the construction works. The Contingency fund would be replenished at that time.
