REPORT

1.0 BACKGROUND

B.C. Hydro Power & Authority wish to obtain a right-of-way over a portion of the subject City owned property adjacent Southview Crescent in the Camrose area as shown on Figure 1 attached.

This proposed right-of-way area will contain a low-profile transformer and switch boxes providing underground power to the adjacent Camrose (Phase IV) subdivision.

2.0 TERMS AND RIGHT-OF-WAY AGREEMENT

The Planning and Building Department and the Engineering Department have no objections to the provisions of this right-of-way.

The City Solicitor has reviewed B.C. Hydro's proposed agreement and is satisfied with the document as presented.

3.0 CONCLUSION


