RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council authorize four members of the Heritage Advisory Committee to attend the 1993 Heritage Society of B. C. Annual Conference in Quesnel, June 03 - 06 and that all related expenses be paid.

REPORT

The Heritage Society of British Columbia is holding their 1993 Annual Conference in Quesnel from June 3 to 6. This year the society is paying particular attention to the concerns of municipal heritage advisory committees. With the anticipated passing of a new Provincial Heritage Act in the next few months, the role of Heritage Advisory Committees will inevitably become more important and more complex. The Heritage Society of B. C. would like to identify the needs of Heritage Advisory Committees and provide some assistance in meeting those needs.

In view of the particular focus of this year's conference, the Committee feels that it is important that Burnaby be represented in Quesnel. For this reason the Committee is requesting that a maximum of four of their nine members be permitted to attend in Quesnel.

The anticipated cost of attendance would include per diem for each member attending for a period of four days, transportation to and from Quesnel and hotel accommodation for an approximate total of \$4500. Should four members of the Committee not be able to attend the expenditure would be reduced accordingly.
