60-21-115 Watermain Renewals - Various Locations
60-30-090 Loughed Highway Sanitary Sewer Extension

PURPOSE: To obtain approval of Work Orders 60-21-115, 60-30-090 and 60-09-070

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT the above work orders as more specifically referred to in this report, be approved.

REPORT

60-21-115 Watermain Renewals - Various Locations
Charge: 1994 Capital Budget
Mains, pumping stations, etc \$600,000.

Additional Information: This work order provides funding for the replacement of aging watermains on streets that form part of the annual pavement rehabilitation program. Construction of replacement mains is coordinated with roadworks to minimize surface restoration costs. The effectiveness of the pavement rehabilitation program is enhanced by reducing the potential for watermain breaks after the new pavement is in place. These expenditures are included in the 1994 Water Utility component of the 1994 - 1998 Capital Program.

60-30-090 Loughed Highway Sanitary Sewer Extension
Charge: 1994 Capital Budget
Sanitary Sewer \$200,000

Additional Information: Appearing elsewhere on this agenda is an item recommending award of Contract #9410, Loughed Highway Sanitary Sewer Extension. Work consists essentially of a new gravity main to eliminate the out-of-date Beta Sewage Pumping Station. The aging facility constructed in 1950 requires extensive maintenance and it would be uneconomic to upgrade to more modern standards. This work order provides funding for Contract #9410 and other ancillary work by City forces. These expenditures are included in the 1994 Sanitary Sewer component of the 1994 - 1998 Capital Program.

60-09-070 Minor unspecified projects including chipwalks, retaining walls and ditch elimination at various Locations

Charge: 1994 Capital Budget
 Special Roads \$25,000

Additional Information: A work order is raised annually to provide a funding mechanism for a continuing program of roadworks including chipwalks, retaining walls and ditch elimination at various locations. The program consists essentially of miscellaneous works to address site specific problem areas as identified. These expenditures are included in the 1994 Special Roads component of the 1994 - 1998 Capital Program.
