The Community Issues and Social Planning Committee shall serve as an advisory body to Council on matters referred by Council. The following categories outline the type of issues that may be referred to the Committee:

- Senior Citizen Issues
- Youth Issues
- Multiculturalism
- Family Issues
- Equity Issues
- Health Issues
- Disability Access Issues
- Crime Prevention Issues
- Health Issues
- Social Planning in Metrotown
- Humanizing Aspects of Development
- Other Social Issues of Community Interest

The Committee may make recommendations for space allocations at City Community Resource facilities.

The Committee may identify issues related to the above categories on which it wishes to make recommendations to Council.

The Committee may form or participate in such sub-committees or Ad-Hoc Committees as it deems reasonable in carrying out its duties.
