R E P O R T

At the regular Council meeting held on 1994 May 30, Mr. Robert L. Howie appeared as a delegation to oppose recent service reductions on the New Westminster Station/Metrotown Station bus route which serves the Kingsway corridor. Mr. Howie advised that the service frequency on this corridor was reduced from a bus every 20 minutes to a bus every 30 minutes after 9:00 p.m. Council referred this matter to the Traffic and Transportation Committee (Transportation and Transit Division) for review.

The Committee, at its meeting held on 1994 June 9, directed that B.C. Transit be requested to reconsider service reductions on the #106 New Westminster Station/Metrotown Station bus route.
