SUBJECT: BYLAW REPEALS

PURPOSE: To repeal three bylaws which have become obsolete.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Burnaby Miniature Golf Courses Regulation Bylaw No. 1205, Burnaby Sale of Wood Regulation Bylaw No. 1823 and Burnaby Service Station Closing Bylaw No. 4266 be repealed.

REPORT

The Clerk's Office has advised the following existing bylaws are worthy of consideration for repeal due to obsolescence. Each of the bylaws listed below has been reviewed and found to no longer have application. We are therefore in agreement that these bylaws should be repealed by Council as a housekeeping issue.

- a) Burnaby Miniature Golf Courses Regulation Bylaw No. 1205 (1930) deals with the specific regulation and licencing requirements. Currently, this activity is permitted as an indoor operation in the Service Commercial District (C4) and regulated by the Business Licence Bylaw.
- b) Burnaby Sale of Wood Bylaw No. 1823 (1943) and its amendment (Bylaw No. 3086) regulate the dealers of wood, sawdust and hog fuel. Regulation of these commodities and their dealers is no longer necessary.
- c) Burnaby Service Station Closing Bylaw No. 4266 (1962) extends hours of operation for these businesses. The bylaw is redundant in that many of these operations are now open 24 hours.

With Council's authority, repealing bylaws will be brought forward to remove these three bylaws from the books.
