RE : CENTRAL PARK POOL - DESIGN OF BULKHEAD

PURPOSE : To request approval for the expenditure of \$10,000 for the design of a bulkhead for Central Park Pool.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT approval be granted for the expenditure of \$10,000 for the design of a bulkhead for Central Park Pool.


REPORT

Installation of a bulkhead in Central Park Pool will allow the summer swim clubs to host swim meets at this facility using a 25 meter course, rather than the existing 50 meter length. The short course length is preferred for regular swim meets, and is a requirement to host Provincial Championship meets.

The process to design the bulkhead and develop an accurate cost estimate to build a bulkhead may take two to three months. Assuming that funding will be put in place to construct the bulkhead, the Burnaby Barracudas Swim Club wish to apply to host the 1995 B.C. Summer Swimming Association Provincial Championships. Their application must be submitted by 1994 May 01. Therefore, approval of the \$10,000 expenditure is requested at this time to facilitate this process.

This project is not included in the 1993-1997 Capital Program. Sufficient Parks General Revenue is available in Capital to fund this project. If approved by Council, this expenditure will be included in the 1994-1998 Capital Program.

At its meeting of 1994 January 12, the Parks and Recreation Commission by motion adopted the recommendation to Council to approve the expenditure described above.
