 SUBJECT: CONTRACT NO. 9414 - EASTBROOK SANITARY PUMP STATION
 PURPOSE: To obtain approval to award a contract for construction of the Eastbrook Sanitary Pump Station.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a contract be awarded to the lowest acceptable bidder, C.A.P. Ventures Ltd., for the construction of the Eastbrook Sanitary Pump Station for a total cost of \$507,501.00 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

REPORT

Six tenders were received by closing time of 3:00 p.m. Monday 1994 October 03 and were opened by staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding. A tabulation of the tenders is attached (Attachment A).


The work of this contract involves the supply of all labour, materials and equipment required for the construction of the Eastbrook Sanitary Pump Station.

The Director Engineering's estimate for this work is \$566,000.00.

The recommended bidder, C.A.P. Ventures Ltd., has satisfactorily completed construction contracts for the City in the past, most recently Contract #9321 for the Beta Avenue Pumping Station. Based on their past performance, the Director Engineering is satisfied that they have the experience and resources to complete the work of this contract.

The funding for this project is included in the 1994 Capital Budget and the Work Order authorizing expenditure of the funds is in place.

The Director Engineering and our consultant, Associated Engineering (B.C.) Ltd., concur with the above recommendation.
