# RECOMMENDATIONS:

THAT \$3,000 be contributed to the Chaffey-Burke Elementary basketball court project, subject to the approval of the 1994-1998 Five Year Capital Budget.

2. THAT Council be requested to direct the Solicitor to prepare a Bylaw authorizing a \$9,000 contribution to the playground projects at Montecito, Suncrest and Chaffey-Burke Elementary Schools.

## REPORT

There is \$9,000 in the Commission's 1994 Capital Program for elementary school playground projects. At its meeting of 1994 March 02, the Commission approved the contribution of \$3,000 each to Montecito and Suncrest School playground projects.

The Parent Committee at Chaffey-Burke Elementary School has developed plans for the construction of an outdoor basketball court. The court will serve both the school and the community well as it is located next Outdoor basketbail courts have become popular to Old Orchard Park. playground features. This school project is viewed as a valuable asset to the neighbourhood playground program.

The School Board has endorsed this project for 1994. The Committee has raised the balance of the estimated \$8,900 project cost, as detailed in the attached letter. The work will proceed this summer.

The Commission's \$9,000 school playground funding allocation is fully committed for 1994 with the addition of the Chaffey-Burke project. It is therefore recommended that a Bylaw be prepared authorizing an agreement with the Board of School Trustees to contribute \$9,000 to the cost of the playground projects at Montecito, Suncrest and Chaffey-Burke Elementary Schools.

if approved by the Commission, this proposal would be advanced to Council following Council's disposition of the 1994 Capital Budget.
