REPORT

The Sixteenth Annual Conference of the Heritage Society of B. C. is scheduled for June 02 - 05 in New Westminster. Given the close proximity to Burnaby, the Committee is requesting Council approval for six delegates to attend at a cost of \$130.00 per delegate. In previous years the Committee has only sent a maximum of two delegates to the conference because it usually entails travel and related expenditures. In the absence of these costs, the Committee would like to present additional members with the opportunity to attend.

The theme for the 1994 Conference is "Urban Heritage: Conservation in the 21st Century." This subject matter is very timely for the Burnaby H. A. C. because of the work progressing on the establishment of the Burnaby Heritage Management Plan which will, once approved by Council, provide the framework for taking Burnaby's heritage management process into the 21st Century.
