REPORT


On 1994 September 16, MCA Concerts Canada is producing an outdoor concert featuring The Moody Blues and the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra in Deer Lake Park south of the Burnaby Arts Centre.

A request to close City streets except for local residents, emergency vehicles, vehicles with handicapped parking decals, concert service vehicles, and Hart House patrons on 1994 September 16 has been received from Staff Sgt. T. Dixon of the Burnaby RCMP. Council approval is required by the context of the Street & Traffic Bylaw.

Deer Lake Avenue between Deer Lake Place and the east entrance to the James Cowan Theatre parking lot will be closed between the hours of 5:00pm and 10:00pm. This will allow access for all emergency vehicles in this area as discussed with staff Sgt. T. Dixon. Once area parking lots are full, Sperling Avenue at Canada Way will be closed as well.

The promoters are aware that approval is subject to the following condition:

1. That the event be covered with liability insurance in the minimum amount of \$5 million with the City of Burnaby named as co-insured, and that the insurance policy include a cancellation notice and a cross liability clause.
