REPORT

1.0 BACKGROUND

Appearing on the Council Agenda of 1994 August 08 was a letter from Ms. Margaret Butschler requesting increased directional signage for the Hart House restaurant. This report addresses the request.

2.0 EXISTING SIGNAGE

The existing signage for the Civic, Justice and adjacent Deer Lake Park areas was developed in response to an identified need by the public and user groups of the area. The design process was initiated in 1989 and included all the user groups (ie. Hart House, Arts Council, Art Gallery, RCMP, Burnaby Village Museum and City departments). The resulting comprehensive sign plan met the approval of all the user groups and the provisions of the City's Sign Bylaw.

3.0 SIGNAGE REVIEW

While the signs have been a welcome addition to the area, some of the user groups have been reviewing potential improvements that could be made to the existing signage based on their experiences over the last few years. A representative of Hart House is part of this review group. Council will be advised if a more formalized and encompassing review is necessary.

Ms. Butschler's interest in this matter is acknowledged and appreciated, and it is recommended that she be provided with a copy of this report.
