**RECOMMENDATION:**

1.        THAT a grant in the amount of \$1,000 be awarded to the Burnaby Christmas Bureau.

**REPORT**

An application was received requesting financial assistance for the 1995 Christmas Campaign. Over the last 16 years it has been the Christmas Bureau's tradition to help low-income families with food gift certificates and new toys for children. The application advises that in 1994, the Burnaby Christmas Bureau distributed over \$76,230 in food gift certificates; 3,981 people in Burnaby were able to sit down to a Christmas meal; and 7,000 new toys were distributed to families with children.
