**REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF COUNCIL**

A meeting of the Executive Committee of Council was held on 1995 August 28 to consider the following grant applications and submit the following majority recommendations for Council's approval:

- a) **46/95 Burnaby Girls U-15**  
**Optimists (B.G.S.C. Optimist)**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$1500 (\$100 each player - 15 players) be awarded to the "B.G.S.C. Optimist" c/o Tami Pulham, Treasurer, 6875 Burlington Avenue, Burnaby, B.C. V5J 4H3 for travel expenses to attend the national competition in Charletown, P.E.I..

**REPORT**

An application was received requesting a grant towards travel expenses to represent B.C. in this year's national competition in Charletown, P.E.I..

The Burnaby Girls under 15 "Optimists" is the only soccer team (boys or girls) from Burnaby to win this honour in 1995. Estimated expenses for 15 players, coach and manager are in the area of \$18,000

d) 48/95 SALVAIDE

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT this grant application be denied.

REPORT

An application was received requesting a grant to support the strengthening of the twin community program in El Salvador. The application advises of Salvaide's commitment to help the communities in El Salvador develop a closer relationship through a liaison in El Salvador. Salvaide received support from a number of the Canadian twin communities last year to hire a person in El Salvador to work on ensuring regular communication between twin communities. This initiative was a direct result of feedback received from Canadian twin communities to improve communication. Unfortunately, the position can only be maintained through financial support and the funds that were received last year have now ended. Due to the need to strengthen the program in El Salvador the application was requesting financial support of the position in El Salvador. The total budget for the year is \$11,040. The application was asking for a contribution in the range of \$500 to \$3000. It is hoped that if each of the communities help in this way support will be able to continue to develop the twin community program for another year.

REQUEST: \$500 - \$3000  
COUNCIL PREVIOUSLY AWARDED: \$15,000

The Executive Committee of Council recommends that this grant application be denied and that the Committee would prefer to deal directly with El Zapato and whatever monies can be garnered be directed to El Zapato and to the aid of projects 'in kind' rather than a staff position.
