RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT, in accordance with Section 267(b) of the Municipal Act, four Consultative Committee members from District #1 (Hastings/Heights) and District #2 (Lougheed) be appointed as delegates of Council for the purpose of attending the National Conference on Problem Oriented Policing 1995 October 20 - 22 at the Justice Institute, New Westminster.

REPORT

The Community Policing Committee, at its meeting held on 1995 October 12, requested that four (4) members from the Consultative Committee's District #1 Hastings/Heights and District #2 Lougheed attend the National Conference on Problem Oriented Policing to be held on 1995 October 20 - 22 at the Justice Institute of B.C., 715 McBride Boulevard, New Westminster, B.C. The registration cost is \$150.00 each for a total of \$600. Funds are available in the Community Policing Committee budget.

The Conference is hosted by the Police Academy Justice Institute of B.C. and funded by the Ministry of Attorney General, Chevron Canada and the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia.

The Committee expressed a willingness for the Consultative Committee members to have an opportunity to share and learn from the experience of individuals who have initiated problem oriented policing projects within their communities. Keynote speakers, workshop leaders and other presenters will challenge thinking about community-based and problem oriented policing. Conference activities such as plenary sessions, workshops and poster sessions are designed to facilitate participant interaction and learning.
