RECOMMENDATION

REPORT

At its meeting of 1995 September 11 a motion was introduced to Council pertaining to the environmental assessment, protection and preservation of the Western Painted Turtle nesting grounds and other wildlife habitat near the proposed trail at the southeast corner of Deer Lake. Council referred this motion to the Environment and Waste Management Committee for review. At its meeting held 1995 September 12 the Environment and Waste Management Committee considered the motion and discussed the information contained therein at length. It is the Committee's recommendation that since the Parks and Recreation Commission have not yet determined the exact route for the expanded Deer Lake trail and that as the process to determine the route will include an environmental assessment that this motion be referred to the Commission for its consideration.
