RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT the 'Resident Parking Only' scheme at Burnaby Hospital be extended by one block along Kincaid Street (3700 block) and MacDonald (4200 block) subject to validation of resident support in the 4200 block MacDonald.

REPORT

The Traffic and Transportation Committee (Traffic Safety Division), at its meeting held on 1995 January 03, adopted the attached staff report prepared in response to a parking survey of residents in the 3700 block Kincaid Street. In addition, the report responded to a request for resident only parking in the 4200 block MacDonald Street. Arising from the discussion, the Committee requested that staff contact residents in the 4200 block MacDonald to reconfirm their support for resident only parking.

SUBJECT: 3700 BLOCK KINCAID STREET PARKING
PURPOSE: To provide information to the Committee concerning the canvassing of residents in the 3700 block Kincaid Street for resident parking only.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT the 'Resident Parking Only' scheme at Burnaby Hospital be extended by one block along Kincaid Street (3700 block) and MacDonald (4200 block).

REPORT

At it's regular meeting of 1994 November 14, Council adopted the Traffic Safety Committee's recommendation:


"THAT the residents of 3700 block Kincaid Street be polled to determine whether there is support for 'Resident Only' parking...."

Resulting from this directive, staff canvased residents and solicited comments on the proposed scheme. The responses received indicate strong support for the restrictive parking program.

We note that the corner property owner at 4011 Smith Avenue requests that the zone not be implemented adjacent to his property fronting Kincaid Street, as he has sufficient on-site parking. Therefore, the area in question could be excluded from the proposed resident parking only zone, as indicated on the attached diagram.

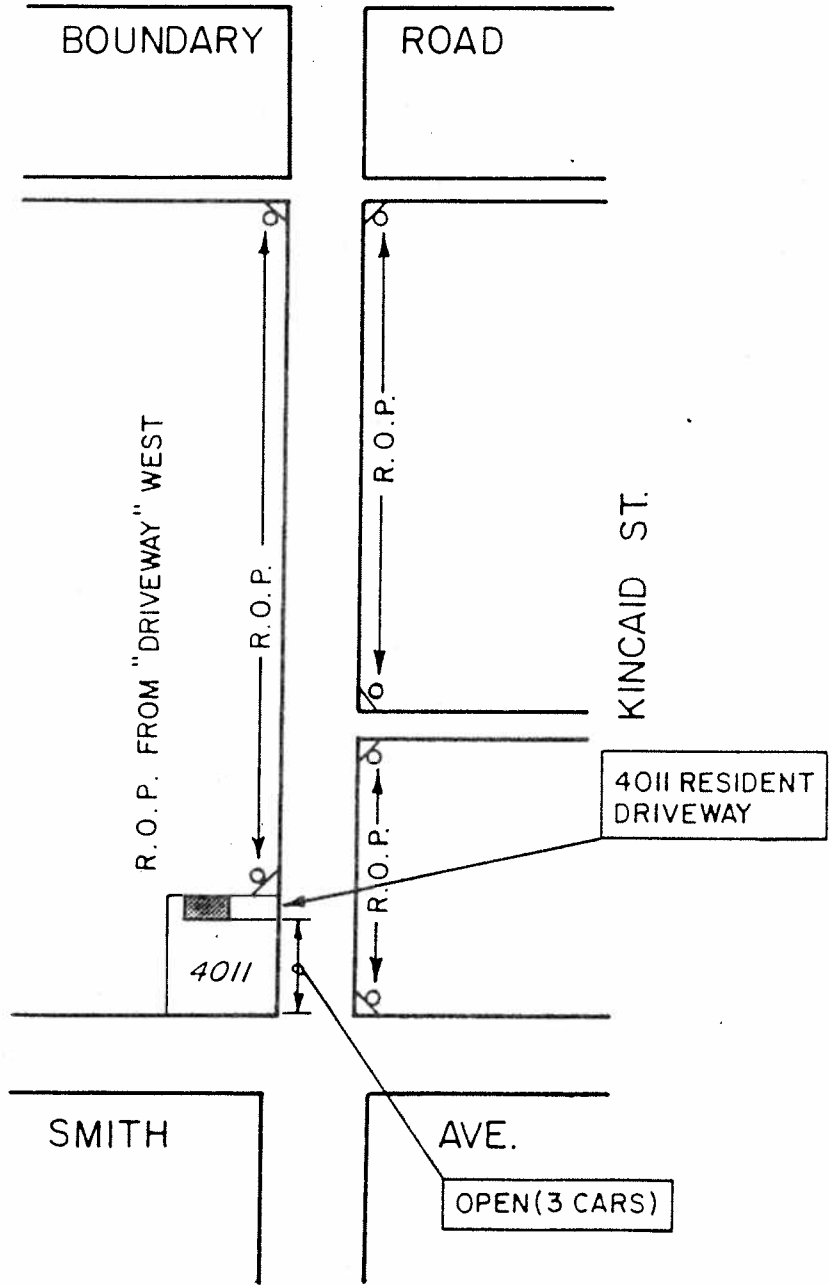
A similar concern of parking congestion exists in the 4200 block MacDonald Avenue, where residents have also noted Council's recent approval of the extension of resident parking only to 3700 block Sunset. Staff has received a petition from Ms. Pearl Dombrosky of 4212 MacDonald Avenue requesting the extension of the existing resident parking only zone. The petition provides as clear a consensus of support for the zone as the poll carried out on Kincaid or the precedent setting survey of 3700 block Sunset residents. Accordingly, staff recommend both of the residents parking only zone extensions discussed in this report.

We, the undersigned residents of the 4200 block of MacDonald Ave., would like to petition the city to post "Residential Parking Only" signs on this block.

Every day our block is lined with cars belonging to hospital workers and visitors to the hospital who are not using the available parkade. These cars are parking in front of our houses for 8-12 hours a day. Because of the congestion from these cars, there is never any room for our visitors to park and we residents do not have the option of parking in front of our own homes.
