BIKE RACK PROGRAM

PURPOSE:

To request Council authorization to pursue a Sign Bylaw amendment to accommodate

advertising based bike racks.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council authorize staff to pursue an amendment to the Burnaby Sign Bylaw 1972 to accommodate advertising-based bike racks.

REPORT

Burnaby City Council, at the regular Council Meeting of 1995 June 26, adopted the recommendation of the Burnaby Bicycle Advisory Committee to pursue implementation of the advertising based bike rack program for commercial districts throughout the City. Staff are currently preparing a proposal call for the bike rack program.

An amendment to the current Burnaby Sign Bylaw is necessary to permit the display of signage on bike racks. The proposed amendment would allow advertising based bike racks in commercial and industrial areas only, similar to the current regulations for advertising-based bus shelters.

Council is requested to authorize staff to pursue an amendment to the Burnaby Sign Bylaw 1972 to accommodate advertising-based bike racks.
