**SUBJECT:** WINSTON STREET - BAINBRIDGE AVENUE TO THE EAST

**PURPOSE:** To seek Council approval to bring forward a Capital Works Expenditure Bylaw in the amount of \$250,000 for the realignment of Winston Street east of Bainbridge Avenue.

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**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. THAT Council authorize the bringing forward of a Capital Works Expenditure Bylaw in the amount of \$250,000 for the construction of a revised alignment of Winston Street east of Bainbridge.

**REPORT**

Winston Street is a major industrial collector street and a designated truck route. The existing alignment in the vicinity of Bainbridge Avenue was originally constructed with sub-standard geometrics due to insufficient road right-of-way. The City has acquired the additional right-of-way to permit a revised alignment and improve conditions for vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Detailed designs and contract documents have now been completed and in order to proceed with tendering and construction it is recommended that a Capital Reserve Bylaw be brought forward in the amount of \$250,000. Sufficient Capital Reserve funds are available and these expenditures are included in the Major Roads component of the 1995-1999 Capital Program. In order to expedite construction of this project, the first three readings of the Capital Works Expenditure Bylaw appear elsewhere on this agenda for Council's consideration.
