**RECOMMENDATION:**

**REPORT**

At the 1995 January 18 meeting of the Parks and Recreation Commission a motion was approved to name the Burnaby Arts Centre as the "Shadbolt Centre for the Arts".

This is to inform the Council of the decision of the Commission. The text of the motion is below:

"Whereas, Burnaby's new \$9 Million Arts facility is currently in the last stages of completion, and

Whereas, the new facility will be a first class facility, and

Whereas, it is customary to name new Parks and Recreation facilities after notable Burnaby citizens, and

Whereas, Burnaby is the long time home of two world renowned artists, Jack and Doris Shadbolt and,

Whereas, the Shadbolts served as honorary Patrons to the Arts Centre Capital Campaign,

Therefore, be it resolved that the new arts facility at Deer Lake be named the "Shadbolt Centre for the Arts" and that Council be so notified."
