SUBJECT: SIDEWALKS ALONG GROVE AVENUE
PURPOSE: To respond to a request for a review of the provision of sidewalks along Grove Avenue.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT this report be received for information purposes.

REPORT

Arising from the "New Business" portion of its meeting of 1995 January 03, the Traffic Safety Committee "requested that staff prepare a report on the provision of a sidewalk on Grove Avenue in the vicinity of Frances Street".

Grove Avenue is a finished street with sidewalks on both sides of the roadway between Hastings Street and Frances Street. South of Frances Street the roadway consists of an asphalt cap with wide gravelled shoulders and shallow drainage ditches on both sides. Permitted parallel parking on the shoulder compromises but generally does not curtail pedestrian usage.

Grove Avenue between Frances Street and Union Street is high on the City's priority list for Local Improvement and we would anticipate its inclusion in the next Local Improvement Program subject to resident support through petition. Sidewalks would be included in the Local Improvement Program.
