REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF COUNCIL

The Executive Committee of Council submits the following recommendations for Council's approval:

#42/96 Multi-Use Community Space Project Proposal

RECOMMENDATION:

1. *THAT* a grant in the amount of \$6,000.00 be awarded to the Stoney Creek Community Council specifically for the Multi-Use Community Space Project.

R E P O R T

The Executive Committee received a presentation from representatives of the Stoney Creek Community Council and the Northeast Burnaby Community Association requesting funding assistance for the construction of a multi purpose facility for use by the Stoney Creek Community.

The Stoney Creek Community Council has committed funding to the project along with the Northeast Burnaby Community Centre, Burnaby Deer Lake Rotarians and an application has been submitted to the B.C. 21 Program for additional funding.

There is a strong need within the Community for a multi-purpose meeting space. Many groups function during the day time and other school facilities are not available. The school population has doubled and as result school facilities are operating at maximum and do not have space available for other groups.

As a result, the Stoney Creek Community Council and the Northeast Burnaby Community Association have undertaken to provide multi-use Community space for the Stoney Creek neighbourhood.

Given the demonstrated need within the Community and the level of funding support obtained from the Community, the Executive Committee of Council is recommending that a grant in the amount of \$6,000.00 be awarded specifically for this project.

#47/96 Burnaby Selects Soccer Club

RECOMMENDATION:

1. *THAT* a grant in the amount of \$2,125.00 (\$125.00 x 17 players) be awarded to the Burnaby Selects Soccer Club - U19 Boys to assist in travel expenses for attending the National Soccer Tournament to be held in Edmonton, Alberta in 1996 October.

R E P O R T

An application was received from the Burnaby Selects Soccer Club - U19 Boys requesting financial assistance to send 17 players to represent Burnaby and British Columbia at the National Tournament being held in Edmonton, Alberta in 1996 October.

The Executive Committee of Council recommends that a grant in the amount of \$2,125.00, which meets the established guidelines of \$125.00 per player for attending national events, be awarded to the Burnaby Selects Soccer Club - U19.

Burnaby Hospital Foundation

RECOMMENDATION:

1. *THAT* the Burnaby Hospital Foundation be advised that regretfully, the City of Burnaby Print Shop is unable to accommodate their request for service in kind.

R E P O R T

An application was received from the Burnaby Hospital Foundation requesting a donation of services in kind for the publication of their newsletter, annual report and special invitations from the City Print Shop.

This service was last provided to the Burnaby Hospital Foundation in 1994. Unfortunately, at that time the grant was discontinued as the volume of work generated by City departments for the municipal print shop resulted in the print shop having to utilize outside services to meet its own demands. As a result the City was unable to continue with its grant to the Hospital Foundation for services in kind.

The Executive Committee of Council advises that, regretfully, the demands placed upon the City Print Shop have not lessened in the intervening years, and as a result are unable to recommend the reactivation of this grant.
