REPORT

At the regular Council Meeting on 1996 July 08, Council received correspondence from the Burnaby Civic Employees' Union Local 23 requesting the City participate in the United Way's Loaned Representative Program for 1996.

For the information of Council, the City has participated in the United Way Loaned Representative Program since 1990.

The Manager's Office is supportive of the request from C.U.P.E. Local 23. Our employees receive the benefits of the United Way's accelerated development program. The training includes professional training in public speaking, sales, negotiations, group problem-solving, goal-setting, relationship-building and project management. Our employees have returned from their experience with enhanced skills which is of great benefit to the services they provide to our City customers.

This report recommends that the City of Burnaby participate in the 1996 United Way Loaned Representative Program.
