SUBJECT:

1997 LEASE GRANTS - RESOURCE CENTRES

PURPOSE:

To seek approval for 1997 lease grants for non-profit tenants at the Burnaby Heights and

Edmonds Neighbourhood Resource Centres.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

1. **THAT** the Committee request Council to approve the proposed 1997 lease grants as contained in this report.

2. **THAT** the Committee request Council to authorize staff to make the appropriate 1997 lease renewal arrangements with the Burnaby Heights and Edmonds Neighbourhood Resource Centre tenants.

## REPORT

### 1.0 BACKGROUND

In 1992 April, Council approved guidelines for the issuance of grants to offset lease rates to non-profit groups allocated space at community resource centres. In general, tenants at community resource centres can qualify for a grant to offset 25% or 50% of lease costs depending on the level of service provided to Burnaby residents.

At its meeting of 1996 September 23, Council approved the recommendations of the Committee for 1997 lease rates and anticipated lease grant amounts for tenants at the Resource Centres. Council also approved a recommendation to distribute the report on 1997 lease rates and grants to tenants with a request to tenants to make application for 1997 lease grants.

Based on the lease grant guidelines and the information received from tenants, this report proposes 1997 lease grant amounts for non-profit tenants at the Resource Centres.

# 2.0 PROPOSED 1996 LEASE GRANTS

Staff have received all of the expected 1997 lease grant applications. The requests received are consistent with the lease grant guidelines and reflect the anticipated lease grant amounts outlined to Council in 1996 September.

For 1997, the *attached* table shows the established annual lease rate, the proposed lease grant amount, and the portion of lease cost offset by the proposed grant.

In summary, lease grant amounts are proposed for 11 non-profit groups at the Burnaby Heights Resource Centre, and 8 non-profit groups at the Edmonds Neighbourhood Resource Centre. Currently, Room 38 at Burnaby Heights remains to be re-allocated. For budgeting purposes, this report assumes that this space will be allocated to a non-profit tenant that would qualify for the full lease grant amount.

The following table summarizes the total change from 1996 to 1997 for lease revenues and grants for both Resource Centres.

### 4.0 NEXT STEPS

It is proposed that the Committee forward this report and recommendations to Council for approval of the proposed 1997 lease grant amounts. Once approved by Council, the Finance Department would adjust the monthly lease charges for the benefiting organizations to reflect the approved grant amount. The grant funds would be transferred internally for budgeting and accounting purposes.

It is also proposed that staff be authorized to make the necessary 1997 lease renewal arrangements for tenants of both centres.
