**PURPOSE:** To respond to a request for the installation of stop signs at the intersection of Napier Street and Carleton Avenue.

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RECOMMENDATION:


1. THAT stop signs be installed on Napier St. and Carleton Ave.

REPORT

As a result of several recent accidents at the intersection of Napier St. and Carleton Ave., staff has received requests for the installation of stop signs at this intersection from area residents.

Both roads are residential with relatively low traffic volumes but a review of the accident history indicates a need for some type of control at this intersection. In the last two years, six right angle crashes have been recorded at this intersection. An on-site inspection showed no restricted vision due to fences or shrubs.

Therefore, in compliance with the isolated stop sign warrant, we would recommend the installation of a two way stop on Napier St. at Carleton Ave. This installation will integrate with a future stop sign control scheme for this area.
