The Community Heritage Commission, at a workshop held on Thursday, 1996 April 11 received information pertaining to the Heritage Society of B.C.'s 18th Annual Conference to be held June 06 to 09, 1996 in Nanaimo, B.C.

This year's Conference, entitled "Heritage is Good Business" is being hosted by the City of Nanaimo, the Town of Ladysmith, Nanaimo First Nations and the Nanaimo District Museum. The Conference Program offers an opportunity for Commission members to see how the City of Victoria has successfully worked with businesses to conserve heritage and to have a look at Vancouver's inventory of significant heritage interiors and their efforts to create a management plan for them. Conference delegates will also learn about the economic impact of heritage on business.

Your Commission feels that the knowledge gained by attending this Conference will be beneficial in terms of promoting future development and implementation of education and public awareness on all aspects of heritage management and conservation.

The total estimated cost for four (4) Commissioners to attend the subject Conference is \$2,500.00 and funds are available in the Committee Budget.
